| Halter Breaking | Using the Teaching by Asking method, halter breaking is simple and painless for you and your colt regardless of his age. Requires 1-2 hours, normally. |
| Starting Colts | For large public audiences or small private ones. Colts started under saddle within 2 hours without the use of force, fear, or bribery. Requires at least two hours as long as colt is halter broke. Additional time required if not. |
| Retraining/ Behavior Modification | For horses that have become ring soured, or have developed problems or vices. Using his Teaching by Asking method, Sam discovers the cause of the problem and eliminates it. |
| Evaluations and Private Consultations | Please see the attached list of Available Consultation Services. If you have a question, Sam will get you an answer. | Training Services | 30 day minimum. Young horses, green broke horses, problem horses, or older horses in need of a tune-up. Horses going into reining, cutting, roping, trail riding, or for you to just enjoy will benefit from being worked with the Teaching by Asking method. You and your horse will be happier and safer. Any breed including wild horses, mustangs, mules, and burros. |
| Wild Horse/Mustang Handling Tips and Techniques | These special horses require a great deal of patience. Sam will show you how to get them to come around and allow you to touch them so you can go on to build a relationship with them. Usually conducted in a one on one setting over a one-day period. |

Trailer Loading For anyone who can't get a horse to load quickly, quietly, and willingly. Your horse will be taught to load in the trailer and you will learn the technique so you will never have a problem loading a horse again. Done without force or cruelty. You will understand why your horse does not want to load and how to correct the problem.

& Instruction** Private, semi-private, or group lessons by the hour. Some equitation and lots of horsemanship. Any age, any level of experience welcome. May get Sam Powell or a Sam Powell Certified instructor. Age, skill level, and your preference will determine this.

**Videotape

Program** For those who don't want to brave the elements during the winter months in order to keep a horse in shape and ready for the spring trail riding/show season. Requires a 90-day stay for the horse.

**Show Horse
R & R** For show/competition horses that have grown ring sour and tired of showing. We give them a change of scenery and a new exercise program designed to keep them in shape and get their minds off the show ring. Your horse will be ready to go back and win again after a vacation at our facility.

Demonstrations Colt Starting demonstrations, trailer loading demonstrations, horsemanship demonstrations. Usually conducted over half day to all day for large public audiences.
